
**Topic:** What is the difference between a Non-Relieving and Self-Relieving mini regulator?

**Non-Relieving** regulators need to have the pressure bleed off the line typically through the air/water syringe to show accurate pressure on the gauge when adjusted to a lower setting. They can be used for air or water.

PN's 7203 and 7204 non-relieving regulators function the same. The only difference is the fitting on the input end.





**Topic:** What is the difference between a Non-Relieving and Self-Relieving mini regulator?

**Self-Relieving** regulators let pressure off the output side through a weep hole when adjusted to a lower setting. This allows the needle on the gauge to show accurate pressure **as** it is being adjusted. Used for **air only.** 

PN's 7205 and 7206 self-relieving regulators function the same. The only difference is the fitting on the input end.
